




Agency Matter and Assignment Types

OPD Represents Clients in the Following Matter Types in All Courts Across the State








New Matters Received

This data displays all new matters received from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024




Matters by Status

This data displays matters by status as of June 30, 2024.




Matter Durations for Divisions 1 & 3
